

Spring Fever in the Park – 2026

Guideline & Registration Form

We are excited to announce that the Chamber will again be sponsoring a Spring event in Kellogg Park called “Spring Fever in the Park”. Members of the Chamber of Commerce, non-profit organizations and community groups/residents will have the opportunity to enter a drawing for a *Spring Fever in the Park* space, consisting of a pole and signage. We will have two separate drawings, one for Members of the Chamber and one for non-profit organizations, community groups and residents. We will start taking registration forms, located at the bottom of this sheet, starting on **February 5th**, and will hold the **Spring Fever in the Park drawings on Monday, March 5th**.

Decorating your Spring Fever creation is left to your imagination, creativity, and ingenuity; however, the following includes some guidelines we encourage you follow when planning your Spring creation:

1. All Spring creations must include flowers somewhere in the design!
2. Decorations may be purchased or made. Decorations made of cardboard or paper are discouraged unless protected by plastic spray or lamination.
3. We ask that decorations designed to feed wildlife not be used.
4. Decorations should be tied or wired securely to your creation to resist high winds and vandalism.
5. Items especially attractive to theft should not be used. For example, beverage containers that carry a deposit.
6. Your company name/group name will be on the sign we provide. No promotional handouts, business cards or other loose items for the public to take are permitted.
7. The Plymouth Community Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to remove any item on or about your creation, or the entire creation, if it is deemed by our discretion to be inappropriate.
8. **Creation ideas: fairies, gnomes, bunnies, ducks, birds, butterflies, dragonflies, bees, spring wreathes, bird houses, gardening designs. You can design a creation with real potted flowers, but you must keep it watered.**

Cost: **\$80** for businesses and residents, and **\$75** for non-profit organizations and community groups (these fees includes City costs and proper environmental disposal fees). Payments are to **be made within one week of notification**. To register, complete this form, which can be emailed to mary@plymouthmich.org, or brought to the Chamber at 850 W. Ann Arbor Trail. We will notify all applicants as to whether or not their application was chosen for participation.

Winning participants can decorate their Spring Fever creations beginning **Friday, March 20th**. Decorating should be completed by **Friday, March 27th**. Please let us know if you cannot have your Spring creation completed by this date.

Participants must retrieve their decorations by **Tuesday, May 5th**, as the City of Plymouth will begin cleaning up the area on **Wednesday, May 6th**. Please direct questions to the Plymouth Community Chamber of Commerce at (734) 453-1540 or mary@plymouthmich.org.
